- 6. Keep equipment, and designated yard and job site areas, neat and clean at all times.

- 8. Inform the Drilling Foreman of any maintenance of equipment, low levels of inventory and necessary supplies.

- 11. Be familiar with state and local codes and rules.
- 12. Understand how to visually and mechanically interpret soils encountered in drilling so that a well can be intelligently designed.
- 13. Complete all water sample labels, paperwork, timecards, and any other tasks requested from Drilling Foreman and Manager by the end of each day.
- 14. Participate in Safety Tailgate meetings and planning.
- 15. Maintain effective communication with customers, Drilling Foreman, and Manager.
